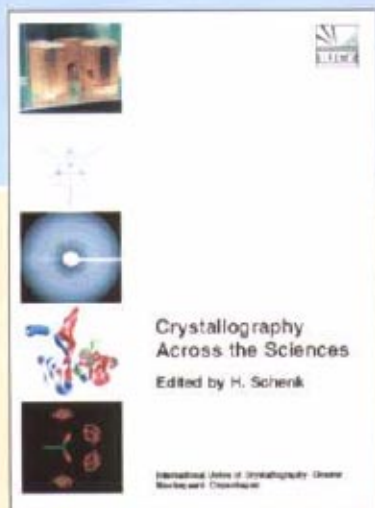


crystallography across the sciences
